



## 1. Does your child have COVID-19 symptoms?

- A high temperature 38 C or above
- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- A loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

- Do not come into nursery
- Contact the nursery to inform us
- Get a PCR test & go to question 2

*- If your child only has a temperature but had a vaccination within the last 48 hours or an MMR vaccine in the past 21 days, please proceed to question 3*

## 2. Is your child's COVID-19 test positive?

- Inform nursery
- Do not come into nursery until their temperature is normal & they have isolated for 10 days, including the day the symptoms started and the next 10 full days (please see below for guidance on when your child can leave isolation before 10 full days), then go to question 3.
- You child can stop self-isolating after 7 days if they have a rapid lateral flow test on days 6 and 7 of their self-isolation period and:
  - both tests are negative
  - both tests are taking at least 24 hours apart
  - they do not have a high temperature

## 4. Is your household member's COVID-19 test positive?

- Inform nursery
- Other members of the house do not need to isolate if under the age of 18 years or double vaccinated.
- Everyone in the house is encouraged to seek a PCR test following a confirmed case of Covid-19. You do not need to isolate yourself whilst awaiting the results.

## 3. Is your child ill with other symptoms not linked to COVID-19?
